### TO ALL COUNTY AGRICULTURAL AGENTS

I know that these leaders can serve as a medium to give to the public the proper interpretation of our farm program.

We are expecting the cooperation of the young and old to work better and longer hours. Our boys are on the battle front and we are compelled to support them by doing what we can on the home front.

Let us not deceive our boys but fact our task with courage and determination. Let me depend on you for your full cooperation.
