## Ticket Information

Tickets for Prairie View A. & M. College home football games may be purchased by letter enclosing check or money order covering price of tickets. Tickets for Prairie View games in Dallas and Houston are also made available through regular ticket channels in these cities, which are usually publicized in the local press. For tickets or further information, write Luther Francis, Athletic Business Manager, Prairie View, Texas.

## Press Passes

The Sports Information Department attempts to provide working press passes to representatives of all media who normally cover Panther games. These Press Cards are good for all sports events at the college during the year. Other representatives of the various media should write to the college for passes, and they will be gladly sent.

## Services

Complete statistics will be furnished including line-ups, game summary, halftime statistics and final team and individual statistics. Spotters will also be provided when request is received in advance. A press box public address system will provide information during the course of the game. Western Union services are available on the campus.

## Special Games

Several of the Panther games are played on a neutral field, but are considered home games for Prairie View. The locations are DALLAS and HOUSTON. Complete wire services are available in both the Cotton Bowl, Dallas and Jeppesen Stadium, Houston. Special Press Box and Sideline Passes are issued for the Dallas game, but the regular Prairie View Pass Card is good for admission to the games in Houston.

## Prairie View A. & M. College

Prairie View A. & M. College is a part of the Texas A. & M. University System. It is a four-year co-educational institution established in 1876 by the Fifteenth Legislature of the State of Texas.

The college is located at Prairie View, Texas, a small community located 45 miles northwest of Houston, Texas, just off U. S. Highway 290. It is only five miles east of Hempstead, Texas, the county seat of Waller County.

Prairie View offers training leading to a bachelor's degree in the fields of Agriculture, Engineering, Arts and Sciences, Home Economics, Industrial Education and Nursing Education. A master's degree may be earned in the fields of Agriculture, Arts and Sciences, Industrial Education and Home Economics.

From an original \$20,000 investment, one building and six students, Prairie View A. & M. College has developed continually into a physical plant valued at \$16,000,000, 141 buildings, 194 faculty members and an enrollment approximating 3500 students.

Dr. J. M. Drew became president of the college on September 1, 1966.

A number-one sports fan and Panther booster for many years, the new president served as Dean of Instruction and Director of the Graduate Program before being named to the presidency.

The new president is a graduate of Lincoln University, Jefferson City, Missouri. He holds the Master of Science degree from Kansas University and the Doctor of Education degree from Harvard University. He served as a mathematics teacher and high school principal in Missouri, his native state, before coming to Prairie View in 1943.

Prairie View's athletic program is expecting to receive number-one support from the new president of the college.

## Head Football Coach

HOOPER J. WRIGHT  
(Maryland State College,  
1948)

Coach Wright was elevated to the position of head football Coach this year following Mr. W. J. Nicks' retirement from active coaching.

He joined the Prairie View Staff in 1961 and served until this year as assistant football coach and head track coach. He worked very closely with Nicks in football and his track team is rapidly claiming regional and national attention.

Wright served as head coach at Paul Quinn College from 1952 to 1961 and won championships there in all of the major sports.

His undergraduate degree is from Maryland State and the Master's degree from Pennsylvania State. He has completed major course requirements for the doctorate degree at Iowa State University.

## 1966 PANTHER



### EOLUS RETTIG

(Wilberforce University, 1933)

Coach Rettig has been a member of the Nicks staff longer than any other coach. He joined the staff in 1952 and has served as assistant football coach and head baseball coach. His particular responsibility is director of the defense. Under his guidance opponents have found it difficult to penetrate Rettig's defensive line maneuvers. He has molded many great lines at Prairie View.

Before joining the Panther Staff, Rettig enjoyed great success at Texas College, where he won the Southwestern Conference Championships in 1934, 35, 36 and 1937.



### HUGH MCKINNIS

(Indiana University, 1950)

Coach McKinnis was an outstanding back on "Bo" McMillan's great Indiana teams in the late 40's. His first coaching job was at Prairie View, joining the staff here in 1950. He left the college and after traveling around the country for a few years, returned in 1963 to resume coaching duties here. He serves as line coach and is also head baseball coach.

### MARTIN EPPS

(Fisk University, 1958)

This will be Coach Epps' fourth year as assistant football coach. He came to Prairie View as Intramural director with the Memorial Center and served three years in this position before joining the Athletic Staff.

His specialty is working with centers and guards, and he is also head scout. Epps is also coach of Golf and Tennis, both teams having won conference championships in 1963, 1965 and 1966.



## COACHING STAFF

### LEROY MOORE

(Langston University, 1948)

Returning to the campus after a year's study leave, at the University of Colorado, Coach Moore serves as assistant football coach and head basketball coach. He joined the Prairie View staff in 1956 following his successful coaching experiences in his native Oklahoma and at Arkansas AM&N.

Moore's teams won the SW Conference championship in 1961 and 1962. His teams were picked as the Number One Small College Team in the nation both years, and in 1962 Prairie View won the National (NAIA) Basketball Championship.

1. LEON CARR — 6' 3", 210. Will lead the Panthers' offense in their bid for Southwest Conference and National recognition.

2. ROBERT HAMILTON — 6' 4", 180. Freshman from La-Marque, Texas will enter this season for his first collegiate experience as Quarterback.

3. ODELL NEWSOME — 5' 8", 160. Is expected to be a spark in the Panther offense this year.

4. URIEL JOHNSON — 5' 10", 165. A sophomore halfback and one of the most deceptive runners in the Conference — should be great this year.

5. RICHARD LEWIS — 5' 11", 190. Is known for his pass receiving ability and will display such in the Panther attack this season.
6. OTTO BROWN — 5' 11", 195. Florida product is classed in the era of the hard running backs. Such contribution may prove helpful to the team.
7. JAMES E. WILLIAMS — 5' 9", 175. Is kicking specialist and has developed a reputation among conference teams.
8. RICHARD JOHNSON — 5' 11", 170. A freshman from Ennis is noted for his defensive ability and fine hands.
9. FRANK PERRY — 5' 11", 205. Leading offensive fullback will bid for his job in the Panther attack.
10. ROBERT LEE JONES — 5' 11", 208. Is expected to fortify the fullback position for the 1966 squad.
11. KENNETH MARTINDALE — 6' 2", 190. Has a great pair of hands and is one of the best defensive players on the collegiate circuit.
12. ALONZO WALLACE — 6' 11", 125. As the best blocker in the center position and will add power to the Panther attack.
13. KENNETH HOUSTON — 6' 3", 205. Top Southwest Athletic Conference defensive cornerback and doubles in offensive center. A senior, Houston, has been picked as an all conference choice.
14. JAMES BAGBY — 6' 3", 220. Freshman center, is expected to help the squad in the coming season.
