A versatile writer, in which she employs a unique style of "play on words," she has written for Church Bulletins and publications for almost forty years. In her native Houston she has been a life-long member of historic Antioch Baptist Church and is a Life Member of the Y.W.C.A., which her mother helped to found in Houston.
