Chief Bennett Back "Look Grandpa, see what I From Conference




Daniel L. Bennett returned this week from Oakland, California, where he attended a week-long national convention of Black Police Officers. The event, which took place between Aug. 27 and Sept. 2, was an opportunity for Black policemen together for workshops, to exchange views, solve probgreat number of topics common to all departments in some degree.

Offered were workshops in test-taking, crime prevention, undercover investigations, police management, civil liabilities, community relations, hiring and promotion practices.

Chief Bennett, who states he's brought back "good memories" of the convention, attended six workshops during his week at the Hyatt Regency - Oakland. "It was a very positive experience." he notes. Flora Nominated For exchange views, solve prob-lems and get advice on a Ministerial Honors

Brother Kenneth Flora. pastor of the Community Chapel, Hempstead, has been nominated for selection as "Rural Minister of The Year," in the state of Texas. He is one of only 24 religious leaders throughout the state to be selected for this honor and the only one from this

Former Houston Oiler defensive end Elvin Bethea has been named Grand Marshall sack. Even though he had of the 1984 Waller County no starts in the '82 season, Fair Parade. The 15-year veteran, drafted by the Oilers in 1968 as a third-round pick, will lead the parade which begins at 10 a.m. Thursday, Sept. 13.

Bethea holds three Oilers records relating to service: most seasons (15), most career games played - regular season only (203) and most consecutive games played regular season only (135). Bethea's consecutive game streak began with the opening game of his rookie season and ended when he suffered a broken arm in the Nov. 13, 1977 game against the Oakland Raiders.

Bethea also shares the club mark for most Pro Bowl appearances with Robert Brazile, appearing in seven. He has also played in eight playoof games as an Oiler, saw action in every game of the 1982 season, was credited with 14 tackles, five quarterback fans.

Bethea is a native of Trenton, New Jersey, where he was born March 1, 1946. the 6'2", 252 star is a graduate of North Carolina A&T. Although he announced his intention to retire after the '82 season, Bethea was persuaded by General Manager Ladd Herzeg and Head Coach Ed Biles to return for one final season.

According to Herzeg, "His value as leader both on and off the field is impossible to measure. He always takes control of situations and leads by example. Few will question the fact that Elvin may have been the best ever pick in the third round of the 1968 draft."


