
UP-N-DOWN By Marty

Waller County Fair Parade A Hit

Judge Virgil E. Mulanax, Republican nominee for Place 1, Court of Criminal Appeals, said he hopes to bring an awareness to the public of who they elect to this Court. Judge Mulanax was in Waller County on Tuesday, Sept. 11, visiting with local voters about his

statewide campaign.

"I am concerned that this extremely important position does not receive the attention it deserves by the voter," he said. "This is our state's highest court for appeal of criminal cases, yet many voters go to the polls without knowledge of the candidates."

Judge Mulanax is only the second Republican in recent history to campaign for a place on the Court of Criminal Appeals. By his campaign, he hopes to give voters in the general election a decision and a conservative opinion. (See Judge, Pg. 2)
