## AGRICULTURAL FILLERS

The present wartime price-support program will end December 31, 1948.

A dollar or two spent for vegetable seed pays big dividends in food, health and economy.

At least eight million boys and girls will get meals this year under the National School Lunch Program, the Production and Marketing Administration estimates.

From 1941 to 1946, living costs of farmers' went up 70 per cent.

Forty per cent of the farm land in the nation is in farms of over 1000 acres.

Texas turkey growers plan to reduce production of turkeys in 1947 five per cent below 1946, due to high feed prices and little change in turkey prices, the Bureau of Agricultural Economics reports.

About 95 per cent of the substance in grass comes from sunlight, air and water. The remaining 5 per cent is made up of nutrients from the soil.

Soil building in East Texas and the coastal prairies depends largely upon the use of commercial superphosphate with clovers.
