History was made for Trinity Baptist Church on June 9, 1946, when the Organ Guild of the Church sponsored a reception at the residence of Mr. and Mrs. General S. In the mid and late 40's the home of the Johnsons was a "becca." The brilliant wedding of Dr. and Mrs. Herman F. Clark (Dorothy Redd) on December 12, 1948 was solemnized at the Johnson home, with her father, Rev. Ernest S. Redd, officiating. There were five-hundred guests. The Trinity Usher Board, under the Presidency of Mr. James Sterling, had several "Teas" at the home, which were a financial success, and augmented the Church Building Fund.
