In follow up with my telephone conversation on today with Mr. J. Mosley, Band Director, I am quoting below the new tuition law as it pertains to out of state students.

"A nonresident student holding a competitive scholarship of at least two hundred dollars (\$200.00) for the academic year or summer for which he is enrolled is entitled to pay the fees and charges required of Texas residents without regard to the length of time he has resided in Texas, provided that he must compete with other students, including Texas residents, for the scholarship and that the scholarship must be awarded by a scholarship committee officially recognized by the administration of the institution of higher education."
