LOCAL HOME DEMONSTRATION AGENT

Dear Co-worker:

During our agents meeting in 1936 (December) you agreed to have your County Home Demonstration Council send the County Quota for 1937 (\$20.00) to the Texas Home Makers Council treasurer by May 1, 1937. Please observe the following instructions in mailing same:

- (1) Make Post Office Money Order to Texas Home Makers Council, Hempstead, Texas.
- (2) Address correspondence to Mrs. A. L. George, Box 516, Prairie View, Texas.

A "summary of prices of tents" and a copy of "agents statements concerning tents" is attached for your information and convenience. I am of the opinion that we could take advantage of a possible saving by buying in a "lot". I'll keep you advised of possibilities along this line, and am asking that your Council refrain from purchasing the tent until after the Executive Committee of the Texas Home Makers Council meets in May 1937.

Instructions for ordering supplies:

Order stationery, report forms, etc., and all supplies that can be ordered without the approval of your district agent on Form 910-E. Mail order to Supply Clerk.

Order all bulletins, circulars, MS articles and other materials that requires approval of district agent on Form D-23. Mail to your District Agent.

"Food to Protect the Health of your Family" will be found helpful with the Home Food Supply Demonstration, order from A. and M.




We are happy to advise that the Knights of Pythias of Texas have again loaned us tents for our 4-H Encampment at Prairie View College in August.
