It is my understanding that an itinerant morse stays in a county about two mont s. The standard nurses course is : -about 24 hours and usually about four hours a week is about as much time as the average person can devote to the course. Thile I am not in a position to give specific requirements, I believe that they rectire not less than ten (10) taking the course and prefer around theaty (20). I am not of the opinion that farm people are in position to take Red Cross Courses in Austing at this time.
