Dear Mrs. Rowan:

I'm just getting around to writ/ing that letter I intended writing to tell you my findings. I'll begin with Grimes county.

The Judge seems to be the whole Court there and he said he was in favor of giving Carrie a \$200 raise if they can find the money. He kept the Court orders and said he would send them to us just as soon as the court met, provided they gave the increase. He wouldn't make a definite promise, but I feel that we are going to get the raise.

I went to Conroe after finding out that the Court there had deferred action on the Agents' salaries until September 1st. I ask Mrs. Watson not to make it known that she intends to leave until after that action. She promised to stay in the County until around the 10th or 15th. I did not inform the Judge of her resignation. I gave her the material for Annual Report and instructed her to begin at once on it. She didnot bring her car back.

In Huntsville, I met the Joint Councils and they voted to raise the money for a Home Agent for 1944. The money is scheduled to be paid in on the first Saturday in October. I mentioned Brazos County to Miss Parker, and she prefers to remain in Walker since relationships there have improved.

We got the two agents in Polk county yesterday. I'm inclosing the Court Order. However, we are working to get it effective in September rather than Jan. 1st.

Mrs. Sadler does not care for Conroe. I wrote Miss Green in Houston and I spoke to Miss Acrey. I'm expecting answers from bothe this week. If you please, watch my mail for Miss Green's letter and read it. I plan to go home this week-end, will arrive in Prairie View sometimes Monday.

Visited a couple of demonstrations here yesterday afternoon. Things are quiet here---not like your last visit.

If anything turns up, will write again.

Dear Mrs. Brown:


