Dear Agent:

This office has received a copy of the approval for you to take leave of absence to attend school at <u>Frairie View A. and J. College, Frairie View, Temas</u> during the approximate period <u>hume 2-21, 1952</u>, 1952.

In line with the approved policy for study leave, you will be reimbursed for actual expenditures for meals and lodging as arranged by the institution attended for the first fourteen days but reimbursement cannot exceed the State per diem rate. Should you not avail yourself of the facilities for meals and lodging provided by the institution, you will be allowed expense up to the amount which is paid by persons who do avail themselves of the facilities provided.

Meals and lodging for the fourteen day period in attending the school should be chronologically itemized on your account to show the date, the town, the establishmet, the particular item of expense, such as breakfast, dinner, supper, and lodging, and the cost of the item. Signed receipts will be required for lodging expense.

Registration fees for attending the school cannot be paid by the Extension Service.

No mileage, transportation or subsistence expense enroute to and from the school will be allowed; however, times of departure from your official station and arrival to the location of the school must be shown.

Your expense account covering the fourteen days subsistence should be separate and apart from your regular monthly travel expense account since you will be reimbursed from funds other than your regular monthly travel allotment. The necessary expense forms for submitting your claim are enclosed. Your account should be submitted to this office in triplicate with all copies signed and the original copy notarized.


