4-H club boys of Caldwell County, all want gilts. Therefore, it is hard to get a boy to take care of a boar, and this make for difficults at breeding time.

On November 14, 1952, I made an agreement with Mr. Maurice Reed, Route 1, Box 23, Dale, Texas, to breed the five gilts in the County Pig Program, at \$5.00 a gilt.

We have many adult leaders of the County, who do not know when a gilt is ready to breed. That is why we have to purchase so many pigs to keep the Negro 4-H Club Program going. Having this breeding done by professional hog raisers, will eliminate some of this failure, until men learn better.
