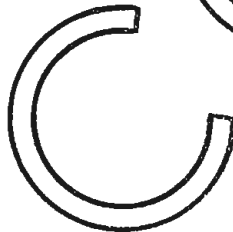

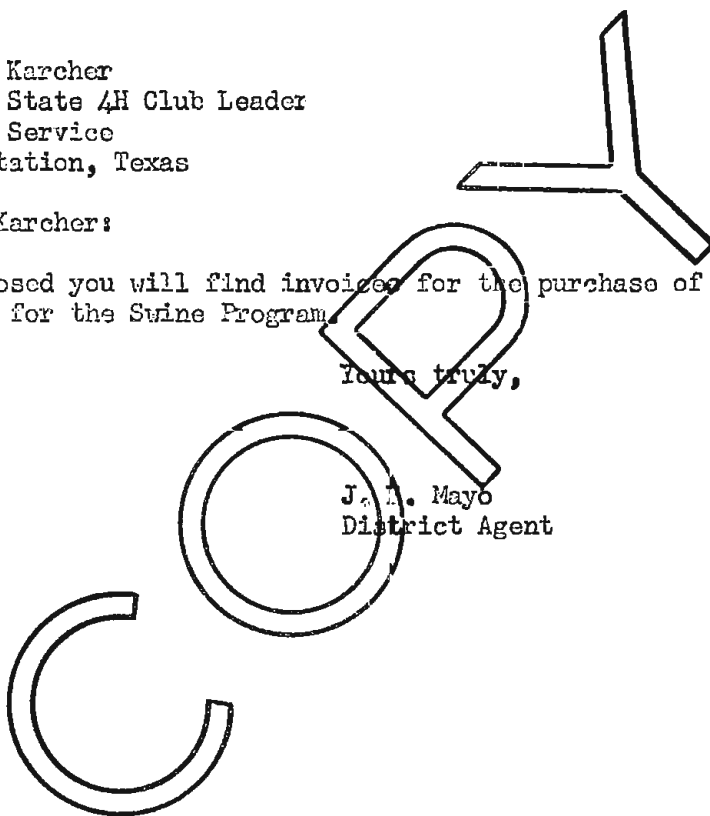

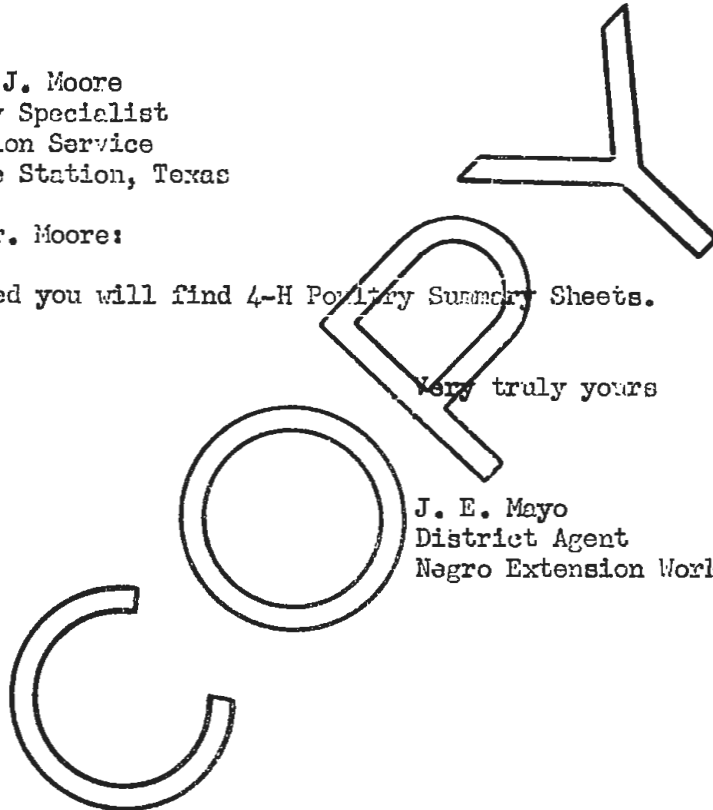

A delay in answering your letter, was to give me time to thank through your suggestion.


You and Mr. W. C. David are the bosses, and if you and Mr. W. C. David say to get a boar, I will go out and purchase one.

We have many adult leaders of the County, who do not know when a gilt is ready to breed. That is why we have to purchase so many pigs to keep the Negro 4-H Club Program going. Having this breeding done by professional hog raisers, will eliminate some of this failure, until men learn better.
