JAMES WILSON — Jr., 6'1", 190, FL

Wilson, a sure-fingered receiver is regarded by Coach Durley as one of the top wide receivers in the nation . . . The speedster from Beaumont specializes in faking the oppositions defenders out of position. He was the fourth leading pass receiver in SWAC last year.

BIVIAN LEE — Sr., 6'3", 200, CB

Lee is considered as one of the top 5 defensive backs in the nation. He is a 2-time All-Conference performer and was named to the Courier All-American first team last season. In three years he has intercepted 20 passes. Scouts and Coaches all agree that he should go in the first round of the pro draft. He specializes in roughing up the opponents quarterback and has winning back speed.

DEWEY ROGERS — Jr., 6'4", 245, DE

Dewey Rogers, a chartered member of the Panther defensive team is called the best defensive line to play at Prairie View since Elijah Childress in 1954. He specializes in meeting at the opponents quarterback.

EDWARD FISHER — Sr., 6'5", 260, O. T.

Fisher was named to the Coaches All-Conference team last season. He has excellent speed and blocks with authority. Most of the Panther touchdowns have been behind the aggressive blocking of Fisher.

LUTHER HUDSON — Jr., 6'2", 190, Q.B.

Hudson came to his own this season, but showed signs of becoming a great quarterback last season during the Panthers' homecoming against Maryland State. He threw for 311 yards and completed 19 of 33 passes and three touchdowns. He has shown his talent as both a runner and passer this season.
