



Dear Mr. Dunn:

Thank you for your letter of September 30, 1965 and the additional information relative to clarifying the eligibility of one of your students.

Last year this student entered Kemp High School. He was withdrawn because he was sent to the Gatesville Training School, where he attended Hill Top High School. He entered October 15, 1964 and withdrew June 1, 1965. The student has entered Kemp High School again; review his eligibility for football and basketball.

You stated that, "Article VIII, Section 14 nor 14d will apply to this case." You are correct. We were not attempting to clarify eligibility in this case, for the lack of information.

According to the information at hand, Article VIII, Section 12, "One Year Rule", would prevail in this case. If the student participated in athletic activities at the Hill Top High School, he is ineligible in football and basketball for one calendar year in the school to which he changes. The exceptions given do not apply to this case.

I would not take any chances that would cause my school to be penalized because of the eligibility of one player.


