Dear Mrs. Rowan:

Last Saturday Miss Hearn and I discussed the matter of our upholstering training schools for the Negro county home demonstration agents.

According to our conversation last fall, I have been saving some time for this in October. Would it suit you to have these meetings on the 16th and 17th, the 19th and 20th, and the 23rd and 24th of October. I realize that you are having some other meetings earlier in the month and it may be too much to have the agents come out for an additional meeting. Is this is true, let me know immediately so that I can make other plans for October. If we cannot do this in October, then I will try to make other plans, but I cannot give you any definite information along this line right now. I might be able to arrange some other dates but they would not be all at one time.

Where would you like to have these me tings if these dates are satisfactory with you? I will wind he are at Longview on the 14th of October and of course if your schedule could be arranged so that I could go to the nearest place for the 16th and 17th, it would be better, although I can make my plans to go anywhere you plan after the 14th.

It is hard to supervise a large group for this work and I believe we would get be ter results if we limit the number who will attend. Miss Hearn and I were of the opinion that it would be better to limit our number to eight at each place, including the district agent in the eight, and select this eight on the basis of those who will be needing it soon and those who are most apt in this kind of work so that they might help others. I would like for each one of your district agents to do the same work that the agents do so that you will be in position to help any agents who may need instructions.

In case we have these in October, will it be necessary for me to order the stool frames for you, or could you get them made by someone there at Prairie View, or could each agent get her own made. Let me know about this immediately as it is getting a little difficult to arrange for making these. You will recall when I sent you the one you have that I did not know how much it would cost and I told you just to wait until I got the bill. Since then I find that he charged \$2.00. The ones I am getting now are \$1.50, but they do not have the walnut legs as he cannot get the walnut any more. He makes the legs of oak.



Dear Mrs. Rowan:

In consulting my October itinerary I am thinking about the work with your agents. As I understand it, my work with you will be as follows:

October 10 - Palestine, 1:30 to 5 p.m. October 11 - Crockett, 1:30 to 5 p.m. October 13 - Marlin, 1:30 to 5 p.m.

I am wondering what success you have had in getting places to hold these meetings. As you know, folks learn much more readily and much more pleasantly if they can work outdoors with plants or can work at a home, either a farm or town, and help the family plan it. If we are going to plan a home, it will be necessary to have a place where we can work. If no home can be secured then maybe we will be able to visit a well improved landscape and help the agents to learn something about design, selection of plant material, and care of it. If your agents are new in the county, perhaps the other agents would be able to help. At Palestine, Miss Susie Brabham will be able to give some valuable assistance; at Marlin, Miss Cora Kirkham would help youragent to secure a proper place. I am not sure about the agent at Crockett. I think she is new there although she has had experience.

I expect to arrive at each destination late in the afternoon before and shall be ried to use part of that afternoon or part of the next morning to check arrangements. I like to visit the place where we are going to work and study possibilities before giving a demonstration to agents.

I am looking forward to working with you. I shall be glad to have any advanced information you may have on the arrangements for these meetings.
