Dear Member;

At our district meeting on Monday, November 8, 1965, it was unanimously decided that no District Basketball games will be played in gymnasiums that are not standard, by NCAA rules. There will not be any games played in gymnasiums where clocks and scoreboards do not meet specifications.

The following schools do not meet the above prescribed conditions.

- 1. Kendleton: The playing court, goals, backboards, and the gym is not according to regulations and students are forced to play without the advantage of an official clock or scoreboard. These disadvantages are not met anywhere else in the state competition.
- 2. Hempstead? The students are also forced to play without the advantage of an official clock and scoreboard. These hazards represent a disadvantage to district players. In view of the fact of the increasing qualifications of athletes of today we wish something could be done about the two schools as soon as possible, so as to prevent hinderences to our students.

Until the standards above are complied with, home games of the above schools must be played elsewhere.
