A crowd of nearly 100 people, consisting of the bank officials and staff, members of the local business community, and other well-wishers gathered under the large colorful tent that had been set up on the bank's newly acquired property on FM 2920, just north of Highway 290.

Bank President Jim Raglin welcomed the guests, and spent

a few minutes outlining the plans for the construction of the facility, and the philosophy under which the bank intends to operate. After Bro. Rodney Bowman of the Waller Baptist Church offered the invocation, Mr. Raglin introduced the Chairman of the Community Bank Corp. Mr. Miles Wilson. This Corporation owns both the Waller Bank N.A. and The First National Bank in Bellville. Mr. Wilson made the point that the two primary activities of any bank are to pay a reason-

able rate of return to depositors, and the lending of money to loan customers, collecting it back with interest. "This bank is here to serve the Waller Community, and will be a true community bank. There will be opportunity for local folks to invest in the ownership of this bank, and we will strive to keep our commitments to this area.

Jim Raglin then explained the actual development of the property, construction of the bank building, and named July 22nd

high school athlete, leading the Wharton Tigers to a Bi-district AAA football championship. He earned nine varsity letters while there. At UT, he had work published in the Texas Law Review, while serving on the staff of U.S. Senator John Tower. After graduation, he worked on John Conally's 1980 presidential campaign. Prior to being elected to congress, Mac worked for two years at the White House, implementing unprecedented budget and personnel savings, while managing staff of 140, and a budget of \$8,000,000.

If you are having any of the problems mentioned above or any other problems, then this meeting is for you.

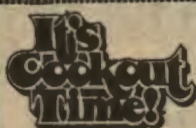

### What's A Fruit And What's A Vegetable ?

When well known vegetable & fruit producers congregate to share ideas with each other sometimes a friendly argument will begin, says David McGregor, Waller County Extension Agent

with the Texas Agricultural Extension Service, Texas A & M University.

Last Monday, while I was waiting for Chris Doyal to change two tires on my car, Prince Doyal informed me about his argument with one of his friends. This friendly discussion was about what's a vegetable and what's a fruit.

The particular plant in question was the watermelon which Doyal states is a vegetable and his friend states that it is a fruit. Other plants that many local vegetable producers wonder about are: cantaloupes, tomatoes and strawberries.

The common sense definition of the word vegetable is a plant that is usually eaten with the main course meal with salt being used rather than sugar. From a horticulturist point of view a vegetable is an annual plant where seeds are planted from year to year. A fruit is a perennial plant that grows year after year after year. An example is strawberries.

Which is fruit and which is vegetable? Strawberries are known as fruit and watermelons, cantaloupes and tomatoes are all declared vegetables by the Supreme Court of the United States.

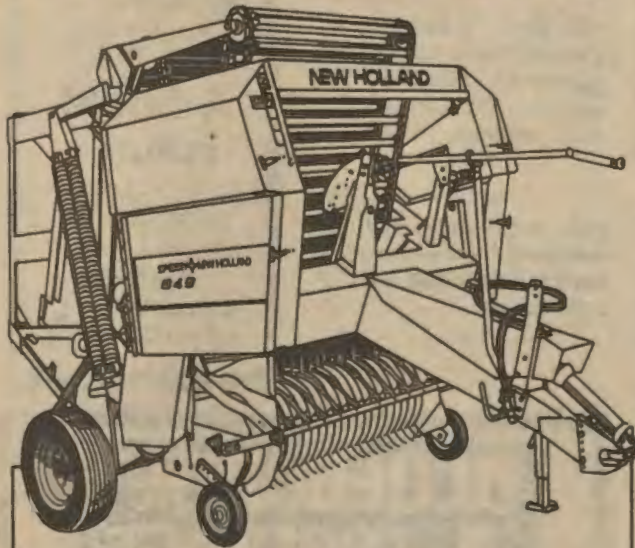

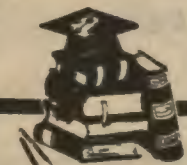

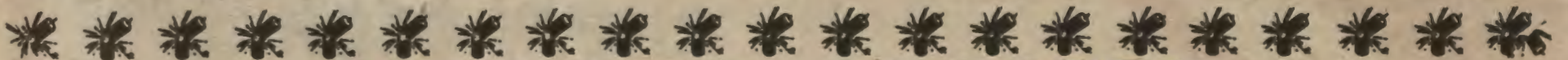
