


Dear Mr. Yancy:





Dear Mr. Yancy:

We held a District I-AA Executive meeting at Terrell High, Denison, Tuesday, November 16. The District directed me to write you a letter asking that the State Director in the classification of schools during the ensuing school term, 1966-67 to consider the size of our district and the distance we have to travel. Due to these conditions, we would like to remain the same as we are at the present time.


We are of the opinion that some member schools in our district are too large for AA classification and it was requested that I secure the high school enrollment of each member school.

Two letters were read from other school districts. One was from Ennis requesting that we accept them in our district next year. We felt that Ennis wanted to leave from a district that is already smaller than our district and it would place too much of a burden on us in traveling, and to accept Ennis would make our district entirely too large for good competition. The other letter read was from Woodson High, Abilene. We feel that Abilene is too far to travel for some schools already in our district. It would require the spending of a night in order to play a game.

If two or more schools in our district change to another classification because of enrollment, it would be so much better if we could remain as we would be then without adding any more schools to this district because of the number of schools in our district at the present time.

It is our understanding that all of our schools that are in our district will remain as a high school with the possible exception of Doty High, McKinney. It is the feeling of the District Executive Committee that we will still be too large if McKinney discontinue playing football.
