Dr. L. A. Morgan, Chairman District h-AAAA Interscholastic League Central High School Galveston, Texas

Dear Dr. Morgan:

Herewith is a report of various incidents that occurred in Galveston on the night of November 13 -- Central Vs Charlton-Pollard football game.

A Gelveston fon (male) took a pom pom from a Charlton-Pollard student. When she requested that he return it, he destroyed the pom pom and struck her with his fist. A fight ensued and a police officer was summoned to assist the chaperon in stopping the fight. When questioned, each participant in the fight accused the other of having struck the first blow.*

After the anc, some of the Central Cheerleaders and students came over to the Charlton-Pollard side of the field and began to tease our students and use abusive language. One of our sponsors had to intervene to prevent a fight. Too, during the entire game, there was undue harassment from tean-agers from the Galveston area who elected to seat themselves in the immediate vicinity of our units.*

Leaving the stadium, after having gone about one block, two of our buses stopped in order to secure ambulance service for one of our students who became ill. While at a standstill, rocks were thrown at our buses and two windows were broken on one of the buses. Of course, this caused unrest among our students. Also, it was reported that an object was thrown at the rear of one bus.

*Incidents of the type mentioned above resulted in our having to move part of the band to another section of the stadium.

I would like also to call your attention to the fact that no police escort was provided to the ferry landing -- out of the city, although this protection was requested of you by phone.

We would like very much for you to clear up the matter of certification of district championship for district 3AA.

The problem that is in question is the certification that has already been made. The decision was not kept in compliance with the Interscholastic Rule Book. The matters that are in question are as follows:

- 1. A meeting was called without notification to all members of the district.
- Certification was made without the signatures of all principals.
- 3. The District Director voted in the dispute to make the vote a tie.
- 4. The school (Hallsville) that was held in dispute was made to leave the hearing without a voice in the matter at all. The school that placed the protest(Daingerfield) was given a vote in the dispute.
- 5. Hallsville school records and birth certificate were not accepted as evidence of eligibility.



- 6. The game record shows Hallsville with a 7-0-0 record, Karnack with a 6-1-0 record and Dainger-field with a 4-2-1 record.
- 7. Violation of Article XII, p. 26 of <u>Rules and</u> <u>Regulations of The Prairie View Interscholastic</u> <u>League of Texas</u>, (5) Duties of the District <u>Executive Committee</u>.

As you can see, the District Director, Mr. Samuel H. Hennington, is in error, and not in compliance with the League Rule Book.

I have your letter of November 21, 1965, relative to the eligibility of a student. The questions were:

 Would a boy be eligible or ineligible to participate in basketball in a AA school if he participated in the same sport in a A school last year? He is eligible in all other aspects such as age and grade.

1 - - - - - 89

According to the <u>Rules</u> and <u>Regulation</u>, Article VIII, Section 12, <u>One Year</u> <u>Rule</u>, the pupil is ineligible to participate in either football or basketball for one calendar year or twelve months. Classification of the school has no bearing on this matter.

2. Would a boy be eligible to participate in athletics in a AA school if he leaves an A school at the end of his eighth grade and enters a AA school at the beginning of his ninth grade year and had not participated in athletics before?

Before we could answer this question, I would like to know where the boys parents or legal quardian live? If in the AA school the pupil did not participate in any inter-school basketball or football, he is eligible in the school district where his parents or legal quardian lives.

Let us not confuse the classification of schools by the League, with that of units, approved by the accrediting agency.
