On Veterans Day, Monday, November 11, 1985, the Waller High School Student Council honored United States veterans with a program

entitled, "Lest We Forget Veterans Day." The day's activities began at 8:15 A.M. with a reception for veterans and community members held in the library.

At the reception, refreshments were furnished by Beta Club and Student Council Members.

The program began at 9:00 A.M. with members of the Waller School Band, under the direction of Mr. Bill Atkins, playing a medley of patriotic songs. The Prairie View A & M University Color Guard then presented the colors. After the Pledge of Allegiance, the Pershing Rifles of Prairie View honored the veterans and

impressed the body with a precision marching drill.

The feature of this program was the keynote speaker, Mr. Eugene B. "Red" McDaniel. Mr. McDaniel's speech topic was "America." During his speech, however, he told students about his capture, treatment, and torture, which he was forced to endure, by his Viet Cong captors. He explained, in detail, plans that were made for

## Statement Of Account Rick Farmer Benefits

The following is a statement of accounting for the monies collected for a heart transplant for Rick Farmer, who received the operation recently.

Funds transferred to the trust account from the various benefits, after expenses: \$65,626.35.

Expenses paid through

10/30/85 include \$304.13 to Showtime Video for raffle prizes; \$179.00 to Houston Radiology Associates; \$798.50 to The Methodist Hospital; \$45,376.47 to the Methodist Hospital; \$1,016.39 to the Coach Light Inn for expenses for the entertainers at the benefit; \$5,791.12 to the Methodist Hospital; \$60.00 to A. B. Fields for supplies for Raffle Prize Dinner. Total disbursements equal \$53,525.61.

There has been \$60.00 deposited in the trust since it was established, making the balance in the Trust Account as of October 30, 1985; \$12,160.74. It is hoped that this amount will help to pay for Rick's biopsies and considerable medicine expenses over the next twelve months.

## Bulldogs Lose Squeeaker

The tenacious Waller Bulldogs hung on to a possible slim win right down to the wire last Friday night in their season finale against A&M Consolidated, only to lose the game by a score of 12 to 7 in the last 48 seconds of play.

Waller jumped out in front in the game in the first quarter, when quarterback Richard Robertson uncorked a 32 yard pass play to his receiver, Vernon Williams, who carried the ball in for the touchdown. Warren Simon made his PAT kick good, and the Bulldogs had 7 points on the scoreboard.

Halftime arrived with no further scoring by either team, but the Tigers came galloping back when, with 8:22 to go in the 3rd period, Randy Stabler picked his way through the Waller defense and ran 24 yards for 6. The extra point attempt failed, and Waller was still ahead, 7 to 6.

This situation held steady right up until the last minute of the game, when A&M quarterback Ronnie Johnson hit Jan Williams with an 81 yard pass play that ended up on Waller's 4 yard line. Johnson

## Terrorist Supporters To Lose Trade Status With US

Leon Klinghoffer, a wheelchair-bound passenger on the Italian cruise ship Achille Lauro, is the most recent American victim of international terrorism.

He was senselessly, brutally shot—his body dumped overboard—during the recent hijacking.

We can derive some satisfaction from the capture of the terrorists who hijacked the ship, and the promise that they will be brought to trial.

that terrorism directed against U.S. citizens and property in the Middle East will not be ended by the successful apprehension of these men, because much of the terrorism in that war-ravaged part of the world is state-sponsored.

The targets of more than 40 percent of international terrorist incidents over the past few years have been Americans and their property.

The United States must find ways to put terrorists, and the nations which support them, on notice that there is a price to be paid for such activities.

The Administration has officially identified seven

nations as supporters of international terrorism: Iran, Libya, Syria, Cuba, North Korea, Nicaragua and South Yemen.

Incredibly, the first three of these nations still benefit from special trade privileges reserved for nations friendly to the United States.

The Iranians, we can say to a moral certainty, were the force behind the bombings in Beirut of the U.S. Embassy, the embassy annex and the Marine barracks. The Libyans and Colonel Qaddafi have established themselves as supporters of terrorism, not just in the Middle East, but here in the United States as well. And the Syrians, despite the help they may have given us during the TWA hijacking last summer, are strong

supporters of the PLO.

Yet these three foreign governments are enjoying what we call Most Favored Nation status, the "Column one" trade preference we give countries considered friends. It cuts in half the tariffs placed on their exports to us.

As a member of the Senate Intelligence Committee, I have introduced legislation that would deny trade preference, including Most Favored Nation status, to any country listed by the Secretary of State as a supporter of terrorism, now or in the future.

Iran, Libya, and Syria would thus be moved to "column two" trade status, at least doubling the tariffs we charge them.

During the first seven months of this year, these three countries exported

\$280 million in goods to the United States. My bill would double duties on crude oil from Iran and naphtha from Libya, among other items, and would triple the tariff on Syrian tobacco.

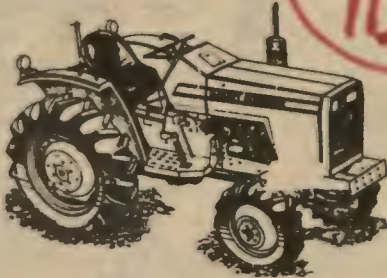
Ending the favorable tariff status of these terrorist-supporting nations will give additional credibility to U.S. Air Force actions that brought into custody the four PLO hijackers of the Achille Lauro, so that they could be tried for their crimes.

And it will tell nations that support terrorism that they cannot continue to do so and expect to be treated as though they are among our best friends.

handed off to Stabler on the next play, and Stabler carried the pigskin in for 6 more points. The PAT failed, and the gun went off with A&M ahead 12 to 7. Waller's quarterback Robertson fired the ball 12 times, completed 6, and racked up 72 yards in the air, while the runners carried 39 times for 92 yards, a 2.4 yards-per-carry average. A&M

rushed 33 times for 99 yards, completed 8 passes for 160 more totaling 259 yards on the night. They also had two interceptions against them, one by Billy Johnson and one by Mark Tisdell. The Waller defense grabbed two fumbles, also. Waller completed their season with a 5-4-1 overall record, and 2 wins, 4 losses in District play.

This wraps up the Waller Bulldogs' 1985 season, but Coach Robertson feels that there was some good experience gained by the underclassmen this year, and that they they ought to be able to field a team to be reckoned with in 1986.

The team would like to thank all of their fans, boosters, and coaches for the support given them during this past season, and hope that everyone enjoyed the season's play.



escape attempts throughout the time he spent in captivity. And finally, he told students about his rescue, which took place on March 4, 1973, which released him from the jungles of Vietnam after six years of struggling for survival. The full account of Mr. McDaniel's life as P. O. W. can be read in his book, "Scars and Stripes. Immediately after the program, Mr. McDaniel flew to New York where he appeared on the Phil Donahue Show, Tuesday, November 12. Veterans and students were left with one final thought, "If something is worth living for, then it is worth dying for. Be proud to be an American!"

Waller High School Veterans Day Choir, directed by Mr. H.P. Kemp, honored veterans with a song and slide presentation. This presentation, reviewed the past wars and conflicts that the United States has been involved in, beginning with the fight for independence from England, to the undeclared war in Vietnam. The twenty-two veterans present were recognized with a presentation of a Veterans' Poppy. Deceased veterans were honored when Taps was played with concluding remarks from Dr. Gerald Slater, Superintendent of the Waller Independent School District.



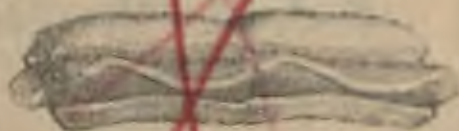

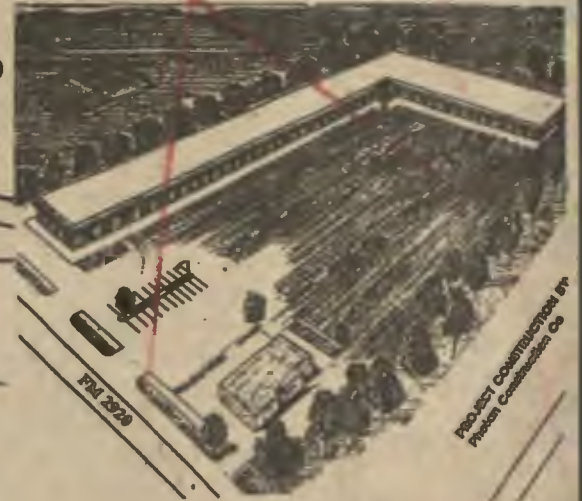
