



Prairie View A&M has served as host team in the Annual Classic since 1928. PV met Wiley College in the traditional game for 34 years with only a three year break in 1956 to play Tennessee State, and in 1957 and '58 with Texas Southern.

The Panthers became perennial winners against the Wildcats and outclassed Bishop College's Tigers in 1967. The Bishop Tigers turned the tide with wins in 1968 and 1969, but the Panthers were victors in last year's (1970) 45th Annual Contest.

The 1971 Football Season is the 50th Anniversary year for the Southwestern Athletic Conference. PRAIRIE VIEW A&M is the lone charter member remaining in the group established in 1921.
