Dear Siv: This is a letter of protest and a letter requesting that you make a decision on the verdich of the high school debate between manor and Lott in the Interscholastic League District Humber Three. My reasons for protesting are numerous. In the first place one of the judges that was used was blind and she scored the children on speech only. She said herself she did not know debate and did not Understand what the debator were to do,

In the second place, the blind - judge gave her scores orally to the chairman of the judges of the debate, who interpreted the scores on the papers the way he saw fit. Was finished, the papers were found to be miked according to the order in which the speakers had occurred and when added the negative side would have wow. We showed this to the director of the judges, and she asked him to straighten the papers according to the speakers, Instead of doing this, he waited until all the other fudges had begun other duties and took a red lead pencil and marked all the papers to his own interpretation, This, I believe, was unfair. Lee Johnson, Director of the District League, to turn These papers over to you for a fair decision. He promised he would.

To accept a non- chalant ruling because, "This is the lash year for Districk 3 Interscholastic League and give everybody a chance " is not the purpose for which I have worked with this team. I do not ask that you rule out the other team, but I do implore you to place allow both teams to debate at Prairie View under non- partisan judger and we can then accept the verdich. please let us know your decision as soon as passible.
