Dear Sir:

This is a letter of protest and a letter requesting that you make a decision on the verdict of the high school debate between Manor and Lett in the Interscholastic League District Number Three.

My reasons for protesting are numerous. In the first place one of the judges that was used was blind and she scored the children on speech only. She said herself she did not know debate and did not understand what the debators were to do.

In the second place, the blind judge gave her scores orally to the chairman of the judges of the debate, who interpreted the scores on the papers the way he saw fit.

Third, when the scoring was finished, the papers were found to be mixed according to the order in which the speakers had occurred and when added the negative side would have won. He showed this to the director of the judges, and she asked him to straighten the papers according to the speakers. Instead of doing this, he waited until all the other judges had begun other duties and took a red lead pencil and marked all the papers to his own interpretation. This, I believe, was unfair.

We pleaded with Mr. Joe Lee Johnson, Director of the District League, to turn these papers over to you for a fair decision. He promised he would.

To accept a non-chalant ruling because, "This is the last year for District 3 Interscholastic League and give everybody a chance," is not the purpose for which I have worked with this team. I do not ask that you rule out the other team, but I do implore you to please allow both teams to debate at Prairie View under non-partisan judges and we can then accept the verdict.

Please let us know your decision as soon as possible.
