

DEADLINE FOR INSURING SMALL GRAINS

Waller County farmers have until Sept. 30th to insure small grain crops. Producers who insured wheat, oats and barley last year will have their contracts renewed automatically unless they cancel them. However, those desiring to make changes in the level of coverage or price election must do so by Sept. 30th.

Crop insurance protects a farmer from large, unpredictable yield losses, says David McGregor, county agent with the Texas Agricutural Extension Service, The Texas A&M University System. It can assure a farmer a minimal cash flow in case of a

Hang in there, Rick! The American way is working! See you up-n-down the road.



Historic Highlights

by Dr. Mildred Abshier

Northeast of Hempstead some fifteen miles or so, lie several acres upon which appear numerous mounds. How old are these raised bits of earth and who put them there?

Some have said that they were shown on old maps as salt domes, but it would not seem reasonable that Mother Nature would push up small salt domes in the symmetrical fashion in which the mounds appear. They are of the same size, some 40 feet across, are now about 3 feet above surrounding ground level at the center, and are laid out in rows that cross each other at right angles. Was this the site of Confederate War camps - possibly an extension of those camps known to have existed in and around Liendo and Clear Creek? Or, is it the work of Indians - campsite or burial ground - or both? Efforts are being made to get archaeologists interested.
