According to the minutes presented to our office, a motion was made by Mr. Turner of New Waverly and seconded by Mr. Powell of Cold Springs that Cold Springs represent District VIII-A at the State Meet since Vernon Williams was not eligible according to documents, etc.

The Committee agreed to sustain the certification made by the District according to Rule VI, under Basketball Plan--Duties of District Executive Committee--It shall be the duty of the District Executive Committee: page 88, League Rules and Regulations.

This is an unfortunate situation; may I ask that you profit from the error of not notifying the State Office and District Director when you found an error in the birth date of Vernon Williams.
