Meets may be held on April 1, April 8, or April 15. Our regional meet is on April 22, and our State Meet on May 4-5-6.



In keeping with our telephone conversation this morning, this is to advise you that several members of the State Executive Committee has studied the Rules and Regulations on the eligibility of the student, Alfred Shaw.

Article VIII, Section 3 of the Rules and Regulations states "No one shall take part in any contest in this League, who at the time of the contest is not passing, since the beginning of the semester or term, in at least three half-unit credit courses (for which the contestant has no credit), to the date seven days prior to the contest". The provisions stated in this rule do not apply to this case.

In spite of the fact the student did earn 1½ credits the first semester, they were not earned in at least three half-unit credit courses. Please read paragraph A of Section 3.

The Committee feels in all fairness to your team and the other schools involved, according to Article VIII, Section 3, Alfred Shaw is ineligible to participate in League Baseball.

I regret very much that we cannot answer your question in the affirmative.


