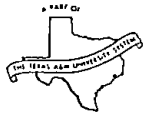

Dear Mr. Cash:

I have your letter of October 2, 1967 relative to the status of your district. May I suggest that you contact Mr. Tom Burton who was to serve as your District Director. In the event his school nor any of the other schools listed are not to participate, I should like to assign you as District Director and let us try to get two other schools in that area and perhaps zone the district until time for District Championship. The two schools in your zone could be Cary M. Abney and Booker T. Washington, Elysian Fields.

It would be well to see the number of schools that are going to take part in Mr. Traylor's district. Mr. Scott of Victory High School, Avinger, called and stated that he did not know the number of schools that are to participate in his district. There is the possibility of there being at least one other school in his district which would give you four schools the minimum in order to set up a district. With this arrangement, we could make league activities available to at least four more schools.

May I ask that you take the lead in making these contacts and let me hear from you immediately.

The registration fees is past due for Class A schools, \$25.00.

We are asking all schools to send their acceptance cards and registration fees, then we can set up districts based upon the schools registered.

The State Office cannot make plans until we hear from the Principals of the schools who are interested in participation.

Dear Mr. Yancy:

We enclose lists of Negro Associate County Agricultural Agents from the Extension Service, as discussed with you some three weeks ago. Please call on the people shown on these lists at your earliest convenience but not later than December 1, 1967.

The following are some of the questions that we would like for you to get these County Agents to answer, but we certainly do not intend to limit your questions to them.


- (1) Are Negro farmers participating in the programs? If they are not participating, why are they not doing so and what needs to be done to correct this situation?
- (2) Are Negro farmers in the county familiar with the ASCS programs to the extent that they can participate in these programs? If they have cotton allotments or feed grain bases, they should understand these programs. Any farm owner or tenant is eligible to participate in the Agricultural Conservation Program and receive assistance of about 50% of the cost of carrying out the practice. If their income is less than \$3,000 per year, they are eligible for assistance up to 80% of the cost of carrying out the practice.
- (3) Are Negro farmers treated courteously in the ASCS office?

When you call on Associate County Agents, I hope that you will make a short record of their replies. At our next meeting, sometime during the first part of December, we will discuss them and get your suggestions. If you run into anything that needs immediate attention, please call or write me so that we will not have to wait until our December meeting to correct whatever problems you find.

We are going to write our offices in counties in which these Associate County Agricultural Agents live and tell them that you will be calling on their counties sometime within the next two months. We will ask them to give you

any assistance that you might require. We hope you won't have trouble locating the agents. If you need any cards or letterhead to write them before you go to the county, we can furnish you a supply. We suggest that you contact the District Agent and tell him that you are going to call on the County Agent listed before making any calls. In most cases there will not be more than two District Agents involved.




