# Dr. John A. Peoples, Jr.

PRESIDENT



Dr. John A. Peoples, Jr., a native of Starkville, Mississippi, was appointed the sixth president of Jackson State University on March 2, 1967. He is the first alumnus in the 96-year history of the institution elected to hold the position.

Since his inauguration, the growth and expansion of the university, physically and academically, have been unprecedented.

Dr. Peoples is the dynamic force behind the development of a well-rounded university, providing a harmonious balance of athletic and academic achievements.

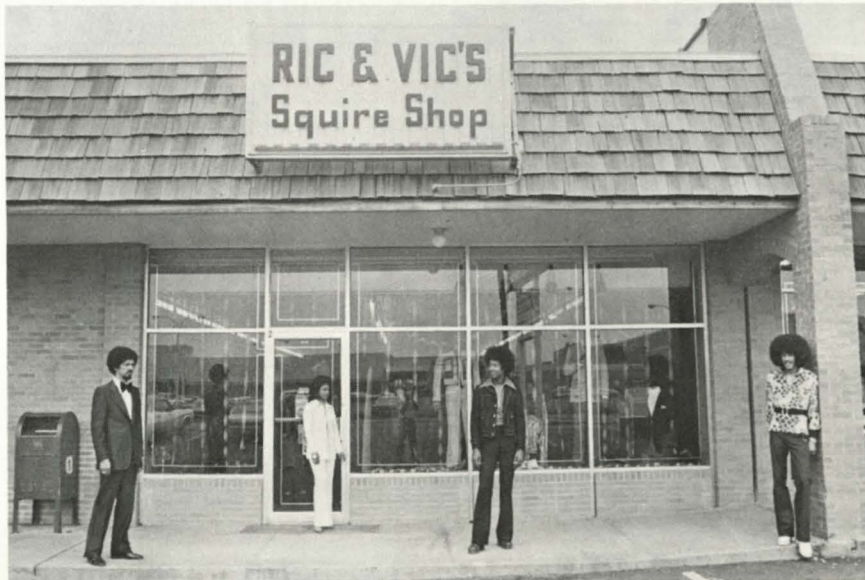
A graduate of Jackson State, Dr. Peoples received the Bachelor's degree with a major in Mathematics. In addition to excelling in academics, he was a member of the football and track teams, vice president of the student government for two years, vice president of the YMCA, and a charter

member of Upsilon Epsilon Chapter of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Incorporated. Prior to entering Jackson State he served 2½ years in the U.S. Marine Corps, attaining the rank of Sergeant.

He received the Master of Arts and Ph.D. degrees from the University of Chicago.

Dr. Peoples holds membership in numerous social, civic and educational organizations. He is listed in **Who's Who in American Education** (1952, 1967), **Outstanding Young Men of America** (1965), **Who's Who in American College and University Administration** (1969-70), **Who's Who in the South and Southwest** (1967-68, 1969-70, 1971-72), and **Who's Who in America**, (1972-73).

Dr. Peoples is married to the former Mary E. Galloway, a graduate of Jackson State. They have two children, Kathleen and Mark.

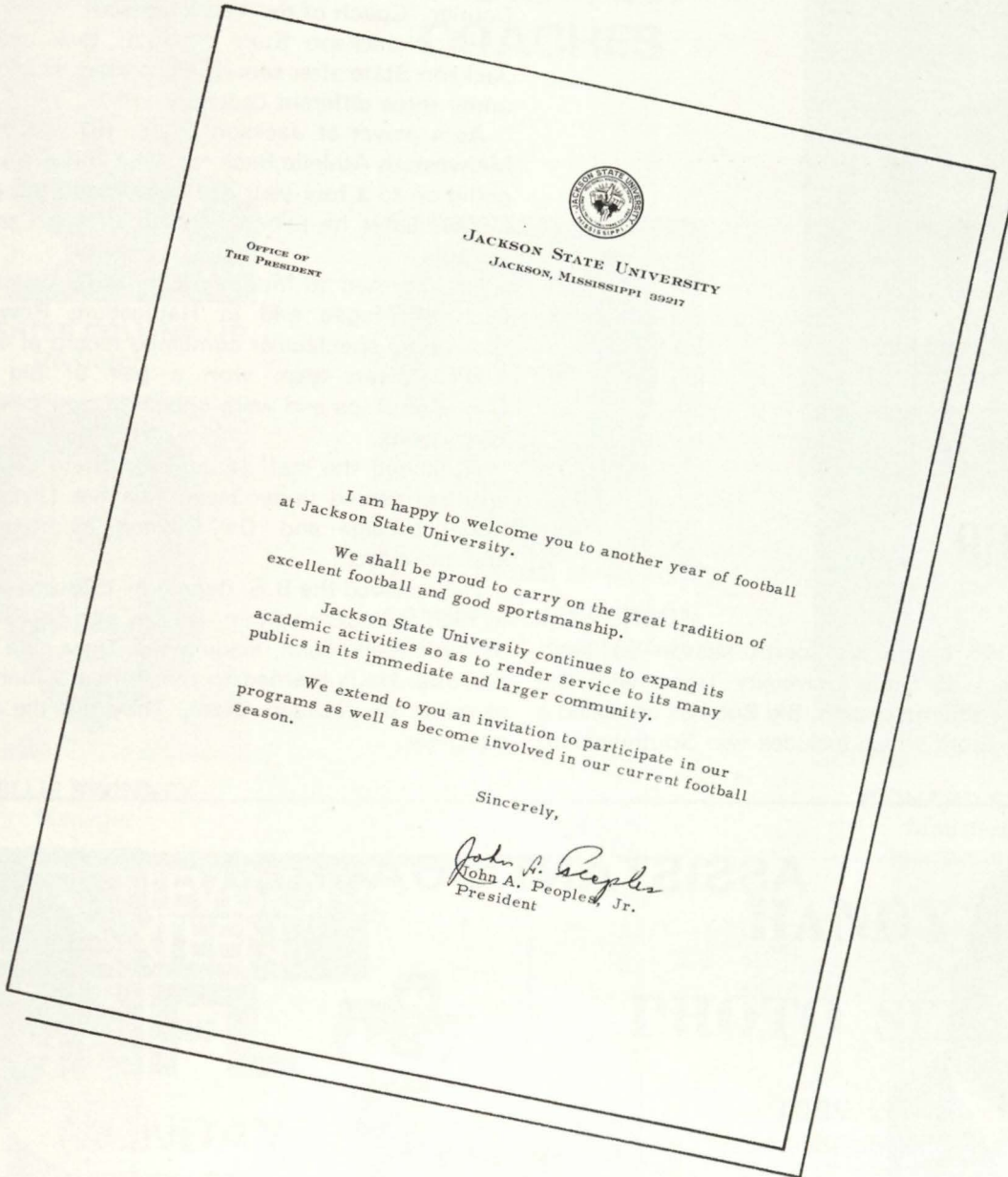

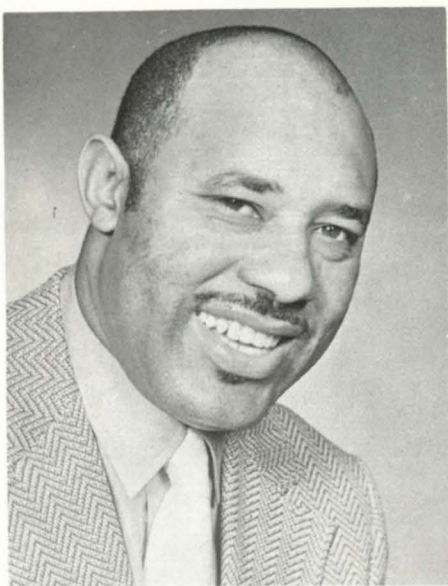

## Robert Hill

Head Coach

Robert "Bob" Hill enters his fourth season as head mentor for the Jackson State University Tigers with the opening of the 1974 gridiron season. Big Bob has compiled a remarkable 26-6-1 record which includes two Southwestern

Athletic Conference Co-championships.

In addition, Hill has garnered both SWAC and Pittsburgh Courier "Coach of the Year" laurels.

Hill, a Jackson State product, took over the reins at Jackson State after serving eight years as an assistant coach under three different coaches.

As a player at Jackson State, Hill was honored as All-Midwestern Athletic Back for three consecutive years before going on to a four-year Pro Career with the Baltimore Colts (1956). Later he joined Toronto of the Canadian Football League.

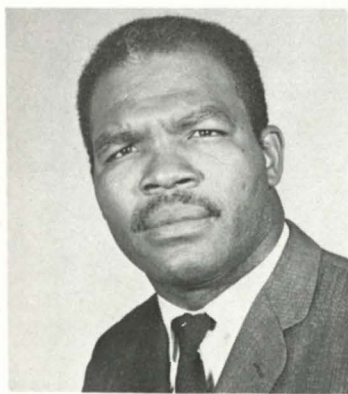
Hill returned to Mississippi in 1960, coaching two years each at Magee and at Hattiesburg Rowan, where he recorded a spectacular combined record of 40-1-1.

His Rowan team won a pair of Big (Negro) Eight Championships and were unbeaten over a two year span in 22 contests.

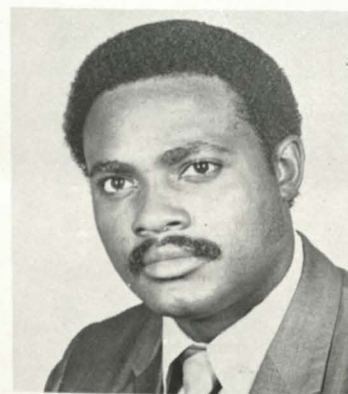
He joined the staff at Jackson State University in 1963, and has served under Head Coaches Ulysses McPherson, Roderick Paige, and "Ox" Clemons as offensive coordinator and line coach.

Hill received the B.S. degree in 1958 and the M.S. degree in 1968 at Jackson State. He has also served Jackson State as basketball coach, leading the Tiger nine into two NAIA playoffs. He is married to the former Yvonne Kennedy, an alumnus of Jackson State. They are the parents of one daughter.

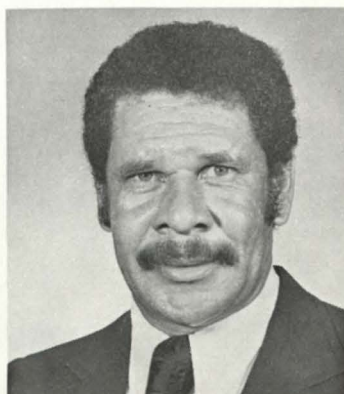

## **T. B. Ellis**

Director of Athletics

The name T.B. Ellis and athletics are synonymous at Jackson State University. Ellis attended undergraduate school at Jackson State and lettered in football, basketball and baseball. He was captain of the football team, made All

South Central Athletic Conference as a quarterback and was the leading SCAC punter.

He transferred to Morehouse College in Atlanta, where he received the Bachelor of Science degree and also earned another letter in football. He holds the Master of Education DEGREE FROM Boston University.

In addition to a stint with the United States Air Force during World War II, Ellis has worked as a laboratory technician at Emory University's Medical School.

Ellis has nurtured the growth of athletics at Jackson State since 1940. Once head coach of football, basketball, baseball, track and anything else you can mention. Ellis took over as Athletic Director over two decades ago and JSU has been on the move ever since. Under Ellis, JSU has gained national prominence for athletic prowess.

In addition to winning four conference championships since 1958 (the year JSU entered the SWAC), 53 Tiger gridgers have gone on to the professional football ranks. Since 1951, the basketball team has won over 78% of their games, including several SWAC crowns and NAIA District 27 Championships. In 1973 the JSU track and field team captured the National Indoor Track and Field Championships at Kansas City, Missouri.

Coach Ellis' wise guidance and leadership continue to be the bivouac of the Blue and White's success.

Ellis was inducted into the JSU Hal of Fame in May of 1974.
