



Dear Mr. Simon:

Thanks for your letter of September 12, 1968 informing me of your District Meeting and some of the questions that came up as a result of the size of the district and the fact that your District Play-off in football will result in State Championship.

In answer to your questions—yes, all schools will be expected to pay \$35.00 as registration fee. You will be paying for trophies and other expenses connected with all League Activities from Football through Baseball which will end in May or about the 1st of June. I am sure each school realizes that it is eligible to participate in all of these activities on this one registration fee and the State Office has never attempted to breakdown fees according to activities participated in by individual schools.

I am not in a position to say what the other districts will do relative to the Band Festival. The acceptance cards are coming in slowly. The activity is scheduled and so far as the State Office is concerned the activity is scheduled with each school.

For the Principals information, I met with the East Texas Superintendents and Principals Association at Crockett, Texas and they asked that Prairie View continue provide League Activities until such time that they could get building programs and other details organized for the complete integration of their school. In the meantime, I was assured that if additional monies were needed they would be willing to assist Prairie View in financing the program.

If any Principal is having difficulty in securing registration fees he may use this letter and I am sure his Superintendent will not hesitate in sending his fees to Prairie View Interscholastic League.

President Alvin I. Thomas along with your State Executive Committee will be disappointed after agreeing to plan for you to know that your interest is only in football and that you as Principals are not or


should I say would like to see the program operated at the state expense when your Superintendents have already indicated that they were willing to assist. We are not asking for any assistance, just the regular registration fees.

Yes, we are going to waver the rule on transfer students coming into your district from other school or students coming into your school that went to another school in the same district. This was done by action by the State Executive Committee.

I sincerely hope that this letter answers the questions and we are looking forward to each school participating in all league activities possible.
