### THE COMMENCEMENT PROCESSION

An appropriate costume is a necessary part of Commencement. The costume includes a cap, a gown, and a hood. Each part of the costume has special significance. The most common head-piece (or cap) for the ceremony is the black square, flat-topped, or "mortar board" type with gold or black tassel. It is called a "mortar board" because it is shaped like the board of the mason which holds mortar. Recently we are seeing large velvet Tam-O-Shanter style of head pieces replacing the mortar board. Some of the velvet tams are brilliantly colored such as orange or bright blue.

The tassel on the doctor's cap is usually gold, and permanently fastened on the left side. The master's cap has a black tassel worn on the left. The bachelor's cap has a black tassel worn on the right prior to graduation then moved to the left during the ceremony.

The hood can be the most colorful part of the entire costume. The colors inside the hood are those of the college or university which is awarding the degree. The colors of the outside rim of the hood symbolizes one of the following departments of learning:

The gown is usually black. The traditional doctor's gown has velvet panels down the front and three velvet bars on the regular sleeves. The master's gown has no velvet, but does have unusually long sleeves. The bachelor's gown is similar to the master's gown but has regular long sleeves which tend to be pointed.

Some gowns may be in the color of the department granting the degree, such as "Education Blue." Others may be "Yale Blue" or "Harvard Crimson" for the graduates of these universities.

#### THE MACE

The mace is an ancient symbol of authority which is carried by the marshal ahead of the academic procession. The mace for Prairie View A&M University is four feet long and contains four bronze figures atop a Honduras mahogany base which tapers to fit into its stand. The four figures are symbolic of the four undergraduate academic years. Within the hollow area beneath the figures, and shared equally, is a flame which denotes knowledge and excellence. The base which serves as a grip and is carried by a faculty member, symbolizes the entire faculty; the stand which supports the mace characterizes the administration. The visual impact of the mace as a whole is "torch-like." The eight tassels represent the academic organization of the University.

### THE MEDALLION

The President's Medallion, the official symbol of the Office of the President at Prairie View A&M University, was created especially to commemorate the lineage of the Presidency by the late Mr. Frank Hayden, nationally famous sculptor and Professor of Fine Arts at Southern University, Baton Rouge, Louisiana. The first medallion was presented to Dr. Percy A. Pierre, fourth president of Prairie View A&M University, on March 21, 1985.

The medallion is designed to be worn with academic regalia at all official University programs. Abstract figures, representing the academic disciplines in an attitude of celebration, encircle the outer rim. The inner circle symbolizes the pursuit of excellence throughout four years of teaching and learning. The weave of the chain is the facsimile of that used by the ancient Greeks.

A replica will be presented to each subsequent President during his inauguration. The medallion will ultimately reflect the history of the presidency, revealing names and dates of inauguration.

She is most proud of the many new programs that have been introduced at the Urban League including the opening of two Business Systems Training Centers (Griggs & Riley Chambers), expansion of the Housing Counseling Project for consumers who were previously denied loan approval to purchase homes, securing a Borden's Foundation Grant in the amount of \$100,000 to create celebratory events in recognition of kids.

She is a member of the Board of Directors of Third Ward Redevelopment Council, OST/ Almeda Tax Increment Financing District, Fund Development Committee of the United Way and, previously served as a board member of the United Way of Texas. She manages a staff of 40 with an annual budget of 4.1 million.

Ms. Brooks received her BA degree from Texas Southern University and her Masters in Social Work from the University of Southern California. She completed the Human Service Executive Management Program at Harvard University. Her education background led her into a successful career in human services in which she spent fourteen years as Vice President of Community Problem-Solving and Fund Distribution for the United Way.

During her tenure as President and CEO, the Houston Area Urban League successfully completed a \$2 million capital campaign for the purchase and renovation of its permanent home located at 1301 Texas Avenue. The Urban League officially moved in its new home in October 1998.

As a homeowner in the Third Ward Area, Ms. Brooks helped organize the Third Ward Redevelopment Council. She is a member of the Third Ward Community Cloth, a collaboration of over 100 human service agencies in the Third Ward Area and Pilgrim Congregational United Church, Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, and Jack & Jill of Houston. Ms. Brooks was recently inducted in the Houston Chapter of Links Incorporated. She enjoys traveling and entertaining at home with her husband, Errol (a great chef) And sons Leland, Chris and Donnie.
