TYPIST

Cortez W. Peters, one of the all-time speed typing greats, will demonstrate his extraordinary typing ability for the instruction and entertainment of local students when he appears under the sponsorship of the "Pen and Pouhders" Club Tuesday, October 24.

In 1941, he attained his highest speed, typing at the rate of 141 net fivestroke words per minute for a period of one hour. His degree of accuracy in this contest was better than 99%. In another professional event, he won the World's Accuracy Trophy.

Peters, who appears here through the courtesy of the Royal Typewriter Company, Inc., has developed an amazing series of speed typing demonstrations. In addition to stressing the fundamentals of correct typing procedure, Peters puts on an excellent show as well. He does a tap dance on the keys to the accompaniment of a record. He takes a speed test while blindfolded and wearing mittens. He recites humorous poetry while typing from copy.
