Registration Procedures For Currently Enrolled Students.

Advanced registration for 1950 summer session for students currently enrolled will be conducted the week May 8 - 13. Students planning to attend summer school may call at the Registrar's Office, secure registration forms, get approval and signature for assignment of courses from their respective directors or department heads and return the forms properly executed to the Registrar. When these forms are returned fees will be assessed and a permit to pay fees will be issued. This permit must be turned in at the Fiscal Office when payment of fees is made. Room assignments will be made by the Dean of Men or Women after the fees have been paid. Registration is not completed until all registration forms have been turned in to the Registrar and all fees have been paid. Irregular and day students must secure proper cards from the Dean of Men or Women before payment of fees will be accepted. Veterans who are day students must secure proper cards from Dean of Men or Dean of Women before securing their receipts at the Fiscal Office.
