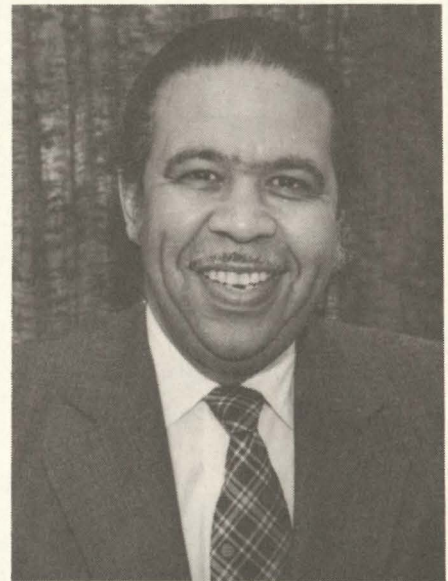
PARENTS DAY **Sunday, April 25, 1982**

6. Parents and guardians input is our most important ingredient for prospective productive people.



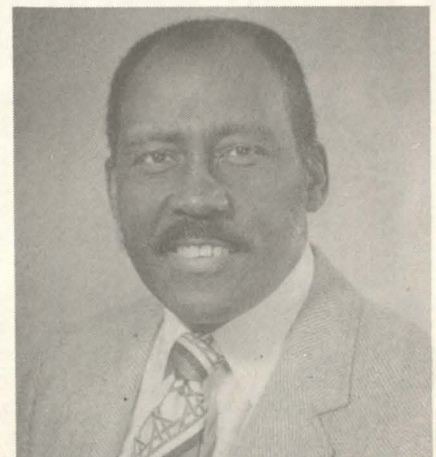

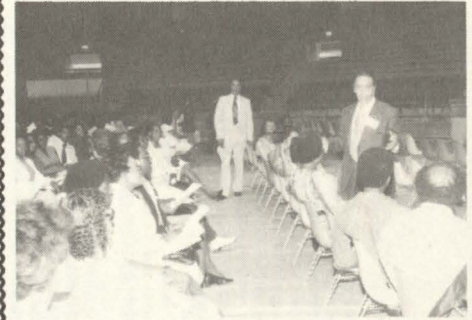
