D. ANIMAL HUSBANDRY BUILDING

The contract for the Amimal Husbandry Building was let to the Fonsworth Construction Company, Houston, Texas, who was the lowest bidder for \$435,000. This building will contain classrooms, laboratories, offices, judging arena, storage facilities, auditorium, refrigeration, etc. The contractor has promised to have this building ready for occupancy by September, 1951.
