It Happened One Sunday Morning

Inside, scarcely noticing the reveling leaves, Sunday morning worshippers had listened to a beautiful organ prelude, sung two hymns, and deposited their coins in offertory baskets, all to the distracting accompaniment of a noisy, wind-blown gymnasium door. It was interesting to observe the struggle for attention between the quiet, planned simplicity of our Sunday worship hour, and the noisy door. Quite unnoticed by most persons a man moved calmly to the gymnasium office, secured a piece of cardboard, fixed it firmly between the door and the jamb, and returned to his seat.
