About Tickets & Baggage

Representatives from the Southern Pacific Railway Company will sell tickets and check baggage in the Lobby of the Recreation Hall from 9:00 A M until 4:00 P M Wednesday, May 26, 1948, and from 8:00 A M until 4:00 P M Thursday, May 27, 1948. Students planning to leave Prairie View by rail should arrange to purchase tickets and check baggage during the hours listed above.

Public Law 16 & 346

The following subsistence allowances will be authorized under this new law:

- a. Veterans attending educational institutions on a full-time basis.
 1. For single veterans \$75.00 per month.
 2. For veterans with one dependent \$105.00 per month.
 3. For veterans with two or more dependents \$120.00 per month.
- b. Veterans attending educational institutions on a part-time basis will receive partial subsistence allowance proportionate to the amount of time attending school.

Adjustments in subsistence allowance will automatically be made for veterans who are entitled to receive an increase. If any further information is required the Veterans Administration will notify each veteran as quickly as possible. It will not be necessary for veterans to write the Veterans Administration.
