#### B. COACHING SCHOOL

Each year, for the past 11 years, Prairie View has made available a Coaching School for the senior high school coaches of Texas. Coach Stevens has announced that the 12th Coaching Clinic will be held here July 7-9. Some of the top-flight coaches in the Southwest will serve on the staff of the three-day clinic.

A special feature of the annual get-together of athletic leaders will be the 23rd playing of the Southwestern Open Tennis Tournament. The matches, including men's and women's singles and doublos plus a round of social activities for the visitors, are highlights in the summer session program.

This in-service training activity is sponsored by the college in cooperation with the Texas Education Agency, the Southern Education Foundation and two other colleges: Bishop and Texas Southern.

#### E. WORKSHOP FOR SCHOOL LUNCHROOM PERSONNEL

Prairie View A & M College has cooperated with the Texas Education Agency and the U. S. Department of Agriculture for several years in providing an in-service workshop for personnel in school lunchrooms throughout the state. Dr. J. L. Brown, who has served as coordinator of this activity since its beginning, predicts that a representative enrollment is expected.
