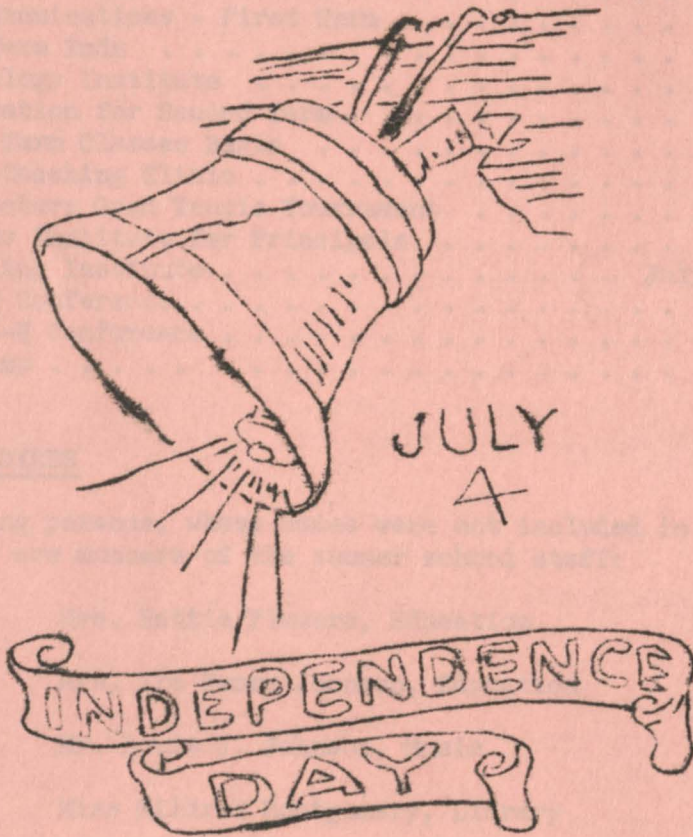


J. IN CLOSING
