## SOME INTERESTING FACTS ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY HONOR ROLL

The following members of the current 130 Prairie View University Honor Roll students are deserving of mention for facts that may be of interest to you. Most noteworthy are the records of Misses Dorethia Collier (2.0) and Doris Jean Hall (2.6) who, at the present, suffer sight handicaps. Second most noteworthy is that there were four students in the entire school to attain the highest average possible (3.0). They are Misses Vander Lee Caldwell and Onis V Fox and Veterans Samuel Collins and Lavaniel Henderson.

Then there are the Sister and Brother members, Miss Meatra Harrison (2.0) and Alfred Harrison (2.2); then the perennial members, Sisters Ruth and Romona Vaughn (2.9 and 2.3) and Brothers Alton and Corliss Branch (2.1 and 2.2).

## SOME ADDITIONAL FACTS

There were 56 male and 74 female students on the honor roll. 48 veterans (46 male and 2 female) are included in the 130 students who made the honor roll. 8.2% of male students and 9.5% of female students enrolled made the honor roll. Veterans composed 28% of total enrollment during the first semester and made up 37% of the honor roll.
