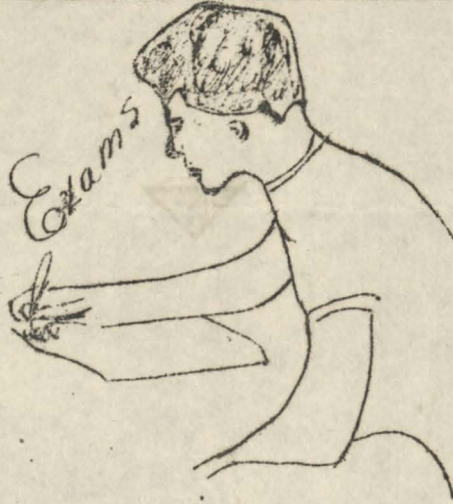

Your application for graduation in August 1947 will be approved provided the following requirements are met:

1. Satisfy English Usage by August 1st.
2. Satisfactorily complete thesis in finished form by Saturday July 19. The completed thesis must be in the hands of the chairman of the student's Advisory Committee by 5:00 P.M. July 19, 1947.
3. Satisfactorily complete work in progress. (Student must earn at least a total of 30 semester hours with an average of "B" or better.)
4. Register for resident study during the second term of Summer Session
5. Pass comprehensive examination. All other requirements except courses in progress should be completed before the examination is taken.
