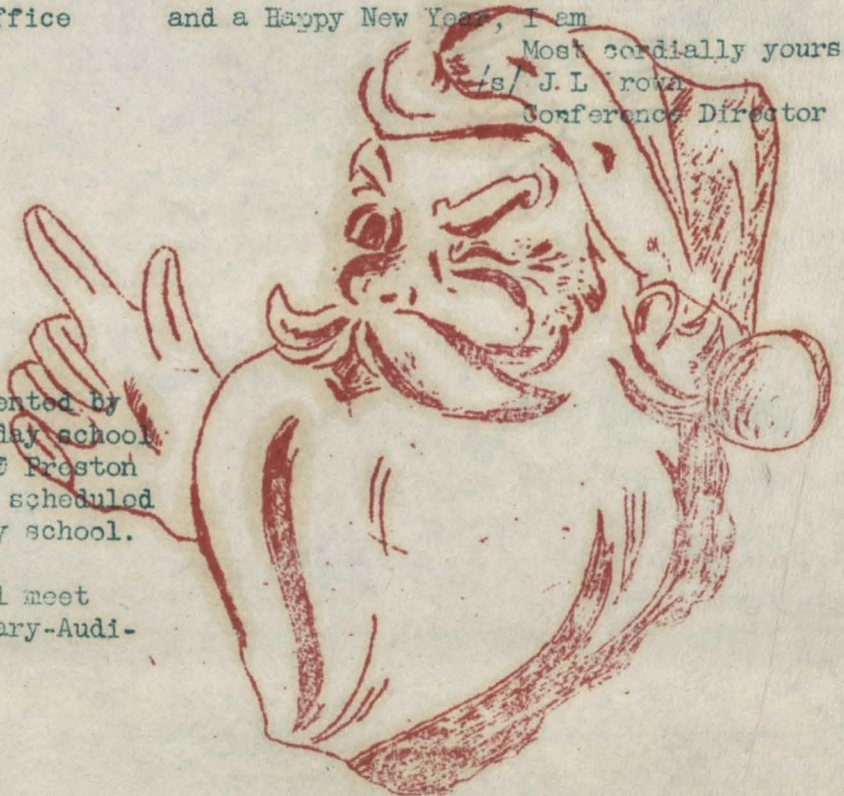

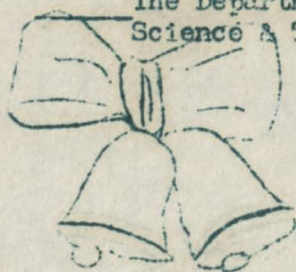


LET US KEEP FAITH
