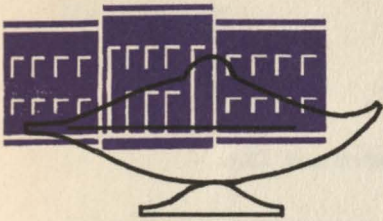


### NEW ARRIVAL
