 4th Day Class Reports: A Teacher's 12th Day Report Card of the 4th  
 class day. These cards, properly executed, must be submitted with your  
 class cards. If corrected or additional guide cards are needed, as  
 result of changes in the printed schedule, please secure re-quired cards  
 from this office before making your 4th day class report. Sign and  
 submit the cards to this office Tuesday, July 25. Include only those  
 students who are enrolled in your classes as of Monday, July 24, 1961.

Commencement Week activities begin Sunday, August 20, with baccalaur-  
 eate sermon and continue through the official ceremonies in the Gym-  
 nasium, Thursday P.M., August 24. Candidates for graduation are cor-  
 dially invited to participate in the events for the week.

Commencement Exercises will be held Thursday evening, August 24, 1961  
 at 7:15 P.M. on Blackshear Field for those who have completed the re-  
 quirements for graduation in August 1961.

Application for Graduation: All students expecting to graduate in  
 August should have made application within three (3) days of the period  
 set aside for registration in the first summer term. If a candidate has  
 applied previously for another graduation date he must call by the  
 Registrar's Office to have his application changed to August. It is  
 not necessary to call by the Registrar's Office to check your status  
 after you have applied. Make your check with your Dean, Director,  
 major and/or minor professors. Usually, the Registrar's Office notifies  
 candidates with discrepancies as early as it receives or establishes  
 the information.

Alumni Candidates: The Alumni Association is happy to welcome you into  
 the group of 40,000 Prairie View Alumni, well over 10,000 of whom are  
 graduates. All graduates receive a one year complimentary membership  
 in the association upon receipt of their first degree. Your membership  
 card will be included with your final letter approving your candidacy
