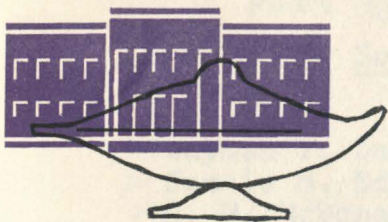

The meeting of the summer session staff, scheduled June 1, will be held in the Administration Auditorium. The time of the meeting is 7:30 p.m.


