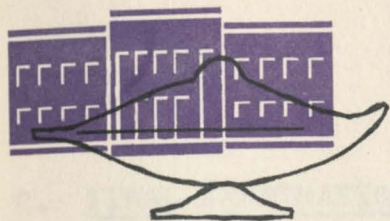

TO MISS JANET JONES, Spanish instructor in the Department of Foreign Languages, who has been awarded a Danforth Foundation Fellowship for 1966-67.


