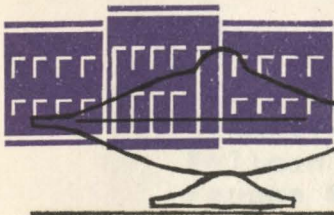

Mr. & Mrs. Jacob L. Boyer are the proud parents of a baby boy--Edward Eugene, born on January 28.


H. GIRL SCOUT DRIVE
