Facts About Our Food Services

In order to intelligently evaluate any operation, it is necessary to have at hand information and conditions which affect the operation.

Whenever consideration is given to our Dining Hall operation, these are facts to be considered:

1. Our food service operation is an auxilliary enterprise supported financially only on fees paid by students.
2. The State of Texas does not subsidize our food service operation.
3. Our food service operation does not receive government surplus foods from any source.
4. Products grown or produced by our School of Agriculture are purchased from the School of Agriculture by our Food Service department at competitive market prices.
5. Breakdown of Board Fees:

Students should cooperate in the operation of our Food Service facility by refraining from carrying dishes and utensils from Hilliard Hall.

Breakdown on Cost of Equipment for the average meal taken from Dining Hall:
